Two chances for each <u>exam</u>:

70 and below on MOED A – automatically signed up for the retest;

71 and up: must sign up for the retest (MOED B) no later than one week before the exam; registration – via the Inbar



Students who received a grade above 70 on the Moed Aleph exam and wish to take the exam again should register for Moed Bet online through the In-Bar portal under the "Register" column below.

The registration window opens 17 days before the exam date and closes 7 days before the exam date (excluding the exam date itself).

After registration is closed, you may register with the classroom proctors. Late registration incurs a fee of 80 ILS, to be debited from your student tuition account. Please register in advance and avoid handling fees.

Electra, a private company, is in charge of the maintenance and management of the dormitories. It is important to note that Electra's contracts span a one-year period, from October to October.






Our Virtual Campus Map
